- 11.A giant shout out to Pam Mondock who offered Life Skills the opportunity to acquire new skills! Life skill students were able to learn how to detail vehicles by doing this on our district vans. It was a wonderful learning opportunity!
- 12. Students participating in the Southmoreland High School BotsIQ team have gotten underway on the designing and building of their 2024 robot. To date no name has been finalized. October is recognized as manufacturing month and to celebrate on October 25, students completed their industry tour of local manufacturing company Duraloy Industries here in Scottdale! Students learned about the brief history of the company and the many projects fields they are involved in. Students were able to witness manufacturing in action by seeing how the main foundry operates from developing the sand molds, melting and pouring molten material into the molds and watching pipes being formed through centrifugal casting. The physical robot is currently in the fabrication phase; the frame parts have been cut out once again by another local company. Reynolds Machine in Ruffsdale with their waterjet cutting machine. Students are currently working with the new CNC machine in the High School Machine shop to accurately drill holes and begin the assembly process. Competitions have been scheduled for March and April.

- 13. The SHS Counseling Office hosted the 2023 College & Career Fair November 15 with almost 40 participants from 4-year and 2-year colleges and universities, trade and technical schools and local employers. All SHS students attended the fair. Positive feedback from participants and students was received. We look forward to expanding on this successful event next year.
- 14. November 8, 10 students attended Penn State University's Engineering Day at the Eberly Campus. Our students were introduced to nearly two dozen engineering programs, including Electro-Mechanical Engineering and Electrical Engineering technology.


