

BUSINESS MANAGER/TRANSPORTATION DIRECTOR INFORMATION

The following reports were posted for Board and public view:

- Activity and Cyber Charter reports are posted online in BoardDocs
- 2024-2025 Budget Updates were given. Ms. Mondock attended meetings with other local Business Managers and talked about 2024-2025 budgets. There was no news on Cyber schools yet. Other budget items reported on were an increase for basic education funding, healthcare could be around 12%, and there could be a nearly \$261,000 savings from the ERIP offered. She was able to reduce transportation by \$10,000, added a technology refresh cost, CWCTC increased at nearly 8.83%, purchased services were reduced and building budgets remained flat, curriculum adoption still the same, & they are still in negotiations with SEA and SEIU so those costs are still unclear.
